A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A GRANT AGREEMENT AND RELATED ACTIONS FOR THE LINDA VISTA SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROGRAM UNDER THE ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION GRANT PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

WHEREAS, on September 26, 2013, Governor Brown signed legislation creating the Active Transportation Program (ATP) in the Department of Transportation (Senate Bill 99, Chapter 359 and Assembly Bill 101, Chapter 354); and

WHEREAS, the ATP consolidates existing federal and state transportation programs, including the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP), Bicycle Transportation Account (BTA), and State Safe Routes to School (SR2S), into a single program focused on making California a national leader in active transportation; and

WHEREAS, the ATP is administered by the Division of Local Assistance, Office of Active Transportation and Special Programs; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of ATP is to encourage increased use of active modes of transportation by achieving the following goals:

- Increase the proportion of trips accomplished by biking and walking;
- Increase safety and mobility for non-motorized users;
- Advance the active transportation efforts of regional agencies to achieve greenhouse gas (GHG) reduction goals;
- Enhance public health;

- Ensure that disadvantaged communities fully share in the benefits of the program;  
and
- Provide a broad spectrum of projects to benefit many types of active transportation users.

WHEREAS, the Linda Vista Safe Routes to School (LVSRTS) project is a 3-year work plan to implement activities and identify improvements within six schools in the Linda Vista neighborhood; Carson Elementary, Chesterton Elementary, Ross Elementary, Fletcher Elementary, Linda Vista Elementary, and Montgomery Middle School; and

WHEREAS, the project will include the four E's of Safe Routes to School programming including: education, encouragement, enforcement, and evaluation activities; and

WHEREAS, the LVSRTS project will include observational studies, community forums, educational presentations, utilize a computer based incentive program named Active4me to log the number of walking and bicycle trips to and from school, convene a school wide safety committee to guide program activities, and recruit an adult volunteer safety patrol to reduce the number of pedestrian injuries and increase walking and biking to school and afterschool activities; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor or Deputy Chief Operating Officer is authorized to execute the Program Supplement Agreement No. 0N29 Rev. 000 to Administering Agency-State Master Agreement for State funded projects No. 00253S for the Linda Vista Safe Routes to School Project and take all necessary actions to secure funding for an amount not to exceed \$500,000 of State Active Transportation Planning grant program funds.

2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$500,000 for the Linda Vista Safe Routes to School Project.

3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing account for the grant, if required, contingent upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement.
