A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR, AND ACCEPTANCE AND EXPENDENITURE OF, A GRANT FROM THE NATIONAL ENDOWMENT FOR THE ARTS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$75,000 FOR THE PURPOSE OF CREATING ARTWORK ALONG A PEDESTRIAN TRAIL WITHIN A CHOLLAS CREEK RESTORATION PROJECT, AND ALL NECESSARY ACTIONS RELATED THERETO.

WHEREAS, the National Endowment for the Arts (NEA) is an independent agency of the Federal Government which has awarded billions of dollars to date to support artistic excellence, creativity, and innovation for the benefit of individuals and communities; and

WHEREAS, the NEA established the "Our Town" grant program to support creative place-making projects that help transform communities into lively, beautiful, and resilient places with arts at their core; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Commission for Arts and Culture (Commission) desires to apply for a grant, in partnership with the Jacobs Center for Neighborhood Innovation (JCNI), from the NEA's "Our Town" program in an amount not to exceed \$75,000 for the purpose of creating artwork along a pedestrian trail within JCNI's Chollas Creek restoration project, which is a part of a larger plan to develop approximately 60 acres of land that JCNI owns in the Encanto area and Chollas Creek watershed; and

WHEREAS, a public easement over the trail system will enable unlimited public access to the artwork created; and

WHEREAS, JCNI is providing NEA "Our Town" grant program required one-to-one matching funds for the project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to apply for, accept, and take all necessary actions to secure from the NEA's "Our Town" program a grant in an amount not to exceed \$75,000 in partnership with JCNI for the purpose of creating artwork along a pedestrian trail within JCNI's Chollas Creek restoration project.

Section 2. That if such a grant is awarded, the Chief Financial Officer (CFO) is authorized to establish a fund for the deposit of the grant money.

Section 3. That the CFO is authorized to accept, appropriate and expend the NEA "Our Town" grant during the grant's activity period, as well as execute any and all agreements necessary to fulfill the purposes thereof.
