A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, APPROPRIATE AND EXPEND FUNDING MADE AVAILABLE AND AS AUTHORIZED BY THE SAN DIEGO SHERIFF'S OFFICE FOR OPERATION STONEGARDEN FOR A PERIOD OF UP TO FIVE YEARS.

WHEREAS, since 2009, the San Diego Police Department (Police Department) has had an agreement with the San Diego Sheriff's Office (SDSO) for joint law enforcement services along the border under the Department of Homeland Security Operation Stonegarden Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, Operation Stonegarden is a regional law enforcement approach that addresses border-related crimes and increases law enforcement activities in the United States-Mexico border areas; and

WHEREAS, currently the SDSO reimburses the Police Department for overtime related to conducting joint law enforcement operations; and

WHEREAS, in 2014, the Police Department applied for, and received, a grant award of \$150,000 for Operation Stonegarden and there is currently a balance of approximately \$100,000 in funding associated with this award; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department recently received notification that it has been granted an additional award of \$150,000 for 2015; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Resolution R-306205 (Oct. 18, 2010) granted the authority to accept and expend the initial grant award and the additional 2015 award for Operation Stonegarden, however, this Resolution expires on October 18, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department is now seeking authority to apply for, accept, appropriate and expend grant funding, including any additional funding made available through any amendments, extensions, or renewals of the Grant, and to continue administering the Operation Stonegarden Grant Program for a period of up to five years; and

WHEREAS, the remaining funds will continue to be used for overtime related to conducting joint law enforcement operations in border areas; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to apply for and accept funding authorized by the San Diego Sheriff's Office for Operation Stonegarden, including any amendments, extensions, or renewals of the Grant, for a period of up to five years from October 19, 2015, through October 18, 2020, provided funding is secured and made available.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend grant funding authorized by the San Diego Sheriff's Office for Operation Stonegarden (Grant 1000006, Fund 600000), including any additional funding made available through any amendments, extensions, or renewals of the Grant, for a period of up to five years from October 19, 2015, through October 18, 2020, provided funding is secured and made available.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing fund for the grant, if required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police is authorized to continue to administer and operate the Operation Stonegarden Grant Program.
