A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, APPROPRIATE AND EXPEND FUNDING MADE AVAILABLE FROM THE DNA BACKLOG REDUCTION GRANT PROGRAM FOR A PERIOD OF UP TO FIVE YEARS.

WHEREAS, since 2008, the San Diego Police Department (Police Department) has received grant funding from the National Institute of Justice for the DNA Backlog Reduction Grant Program to reduce forensic DNA sample turnaround time, increase the throughput of DNA samples through public DNA laboratories, and reduce DNA forensic casework backlogs; and

WHEREAS, in 2014, the Police Department was awarded \$341,000 for this grant and there is currently a balance of approximately \$173,000; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Resolution R-306276 (Nov. 16, 2010) granted the authority to accept and expend the initial grant award and the additional 2014 award for the DNA Backlog Reduction Grant Program, however, this Resolution expires on November 16, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department is now seeking authority to apply for, accept, appropriate and expend grant funding, including any additional funding made available through any amendments, extensions, or renewals of the Grant, so it can continue administering the DNA Backlog Reduction Grant Program for a period of up to five years; and

WHEREAS, these funds will continue to be used to reduce DNA forensic casework backlogs and to decrease turnaround time; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to apply for and accept funding authorized by National Institute of Justice DNA Backlog Reduction Grant Program, including any amendments, extensions, or renewals of

the Grant, for a period of up to five years from November 16, 2015, through November 15, 2020, provided funding is secured and made available.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend grant funding authorized by the National Institute of Justice DNA Backlog Reduction Grant Program (Grant 1000013, Fund 600000), including any additional funding made available through any amendments, extensions, or renewals of the Grant, for a period of up to five years from November 16, 2015, through November 15, 2020, provided funding is secured and made available.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing fund for the grant, if required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police is authorized to continue to administer and operate the National Institute of Justice DNA Backlog Reduction Grant Program.
