A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDING FOR THE PAY FOR SUCCESS SAN DIEGO HEALTHY HOMES SUSTAINABLE FINANCING STRATEGY AND AUTHORIZING RELATED GRANT AGREEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) have grant funding available to the City of San Diego (City) for the purpose of developing a Pay for Success (PfS) financing strategy for the City's Healthy Homes Program; and

WHEREAS, a Pay for Success (PfS) financing strategy relies on private investors to fund targeted interventions that prevent disease and reduce healthcare costs, and financial stakeholders, such as health insurers, to pay a portion of validated savings back to investors; and

WHEREAS, as a requirement of the HUD grant, the City must subcontract through HUD Contractor QuanTech, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, subject to Council approval, the grant funding would be used by the City's Healthy Homes Program to develop a Pay for Success (PfS) financing strategy, known as the San Diego Healthy Homes Sustainable Financing Strategy (SDHHSFS), in order to provide additional funding for in-home asthma intervention for children; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to execute a grant agreement with U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Contractor QuanTech, Inc., in the amount of \$75,000, for the period of its Effective Date through February 11, 2016, under the terms and conditions set forth in the agreement on file with the City Clerk as Document No. RR-

310007 ____, for the purpose of developing a Pay for Success (PfS) San Diego . Healthy Homes Sustainable Financing Strategy.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to negotiate and execute a first amendment to the grant agreement with HUD Contractor QuanTech, Inc., for the period of February 12, 2016 through February 11, 2017, in the amount of \$75,000, for the purpose of developing a PfS San Diego Healthy Homes Sustainable Financing Strategy, contingent upon the availability of additional HUD grant funds for the term of the first amendment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to negotiate and execute a grant agreement with U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), in the amount of \$60,000, for the purpose of developing a PfS San Diego Healthy Homes Sustainable Financing Strategy.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend \$75,000 in grant funds from HUD from Fund No. 600000, Grant Fund Federal, for the purpose of developing a PfS San Diego Healthy Homes Sustainable Financing Strategy, contingent upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement with HUD Contractor OuanTech, Inc.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend \$75,000 in grant funds from HUD from Fund No. 600000, Grant Fund Federal, for the purpose of developing a PfS San Diego Healthy Homes Sustainable Financing Strategy, contingent upon receipt of a fully executed first amendment to the grant agreement with HUD Contractor QuanTech, Inc.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend \$60,000 in grant funds from EPA from Fund No. 600000, Grant Fund Federal, for the purpose of developing a PfS San Diego Healthy Homes Sustainable Financing Strategy, contingent upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement with EPA.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to take all necessary action to administer, monitor and manage the grant agreements, and to develop, advertise, negotiate, award and execute contracts with third parties to implement the grant agreements.
