DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE NOV 03 2015

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, APPROPRIATE AND EXPEND \$363,337 IN INITIAL GRANT FUNDS, AND ANY ADDITIONAL FUNDING MADE AVAILABLE AND SECURED, FROM THE INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN (ICAC) TASK FORCE GRANT PROGRAM AND TO ADMINISTER AND OPERATE THE GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the federal government has continued to make grant funds available to law enforcement through the United States Department of Justice (DOJ) for the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force Program (Program); and

WHEREAS, the ICAC Program has become an established part of the San Diego County law enforcement community and it has brought an effective combination of computer technology and investigative expertise to fight online exploitation of children; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) through the San Diego Police Department (Police Department) has participated in the ICAC Program since 2000; and

WHEREAS, the ICAC Grant Program has awarded the Police Department initial grant funds of \$363,337; and

WHEREAS, this funding will be used for salaries for two Police Department Detectives, one San Diego Sheriff's Department Detective, and one District Attorney Investigator, related overtime, training and travel for San Diego ICAC Task Force members, school safety presentations, and computer forensic tools and other supplies; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds will continue to be used for conducting both proactive and reactive investigations into computer/technology crimes perpetrated against children and youth, serve as a forensic resource to agencies located within the geographical area of service, respond

to referrals from agencies (other task forces, federal partners, Cyber-tips, etc.) and participate in nationally coordinated investigations, engage in law enforcement and community outreach activities including training, prevention, and education activities, formalize law enforcement partnerships that include adoption of federal ICAC Task Force investigative standards, and provide assistance to participating agencies through training opportunities and equipment, as funding allows; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department is now seeking authority to apply for, accept, appropriate and expend the initial grant funding awarded by the ICAC Grant Program including any additional funding made available through any amendments, extensions, or renewals for the grant, and to continue administering the grant for a period of up to five years; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to apply for and accept funding authorized by the DOJ Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention ICAC Grant Program, including any amendments, extensions or renewals of the grant for a period of up to five years, provided funding is secured and made available.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend \$363,337 in initial grant funds authorized by the DOJ Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Fiscal Year 2015 ICAC Grant Program (Grant 1000008, Fund 600000) and any additional funding that is secured and made available through amendments, extensions or renewals of the grant for a period of up to five years.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing fund for the grant, if required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police is authorized to continue to administer and operate the ICAC Grant Program.
