A RESOLUTION DENYING AN APPEAL AND UPHOLDING THE ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION FOR 1028 BUENOS AVENUE MEDICAL MARIJUANA CONSUMER COOPERATIVE PROJECT (PROJECT NO. 369290).

WHEREAS, an application was submitted for Conditional Use Permit for a medical marijuana consumer cooperative (MMCC) located at 1028 Buenos Avenue (Project); and

WHEREAS, on August 10, 2015, the Environmental Analysis Section of the

Development Services Department determined the project to be exempt from the California

Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15303 (New

Construction or Conversion of Small Structures) and a Notice of Right to Appeal Environmental

Determination was posted; and

WHEREAS, on August 24, 2015, Todd Murray filed an Environmental Determination Appeals Application (Appeal) with the City's Development Services Department stating that the Project is likely to have a significant impact on the environment, and an environmental study should have been performed given the lack of appropriate categorical or statutory exemption; and

WHEREAS, the Appeal was heard before the City Council on October 27, 2015; and WHERAS, the Project involves the conversion to an MMCC use of 2,452 square feet, within an existing 16,542 square foot building in an urbanized area with only minor modifications to the exterior of the structure, not involving the use of significant amounts of hazardous materials; and

WHEREAS, the Project is located on a site zoned for its use where all necessary public services and facilities are available, and is not located in an environmentally sensitive area; and

WHEREAS, approval of the Project would not result in a significant effect on the

environment; and

WHEREAS, the Project is exempt under CEQA Guidelines Sections 15303; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 280(a)(2), this resolution is not subject to veto by the

Mayor because this matter requires the City Council to act as a quasi-judicial body and where a

public hearing was required by law implicating due process rights of individuals affected by the

decision and where the Council was required by law to consider evidence at the hearing and to

make legal findings based on the evidence presented; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Appeal is

hereby denied and the environmental determination is upheld.
