DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE NOV 20 2015

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE APPROVAL TO CONVERT THE ALLEY NORTH OF K STREET BETWEEN 31<sup>ST</sup> STREET AND 32<sup>ND</sup> STREET TO A ONE-WAY EASTBOUND OPERATION IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO EXEMPTION 15301.

WHEREAS, the Transportation Engineering Operations Division of the Transportation and Stormwater Department has received a request to convert the alley north of K Street between 31<sup>st</sup> Street and 32<sup>nd</sup> Street to a one-way eastbound operation; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the conversion of the alley north of K Street between 31<sup>st</sup> Street and 32<sup>nd</sup> Street to an one-way eastbound operation, and

WHEREAS, on NOV 03 2015, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has determined that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment because it involves a minor alteration to an existing public facility with negligible or no expansion of use; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the conversion of the alley north of K Street between 31<sup>st</sup> Street and 32<sup>nd</sup> Street to a one-way eastbound operation is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
