A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE EXECUTION OF AN ASNEEDED CONSULTANT AGREEMENT WITH STC TRAFFIC, INC. IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO EXEMPTION 15301.

WHEREAS, the City intends to enter into an agreement with STC Traffic, Inc. for Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) Consulting Services on an as-needed basis; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the consulting services to be provided by STC Traffic, Inc.; and WHEREAS, on NOV 1:0 2015 , the City Council held a duly noticed

public meeting and considered the written record for the project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has determined that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment because it will involve minor alterations to existing public facilities with negligible or no expansion of use; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the agreement with STC Traffic, Inc. for Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) Consulting Services on an as-needed basis is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Co	unch of the City of San Diego has
determined that an exception to the exemption as se	t forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2
does not apply.
