A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING FUNDING AND EXPENDITURE  
FOR THE EL CAJON BOULEVARD PEDESTRIAN  
IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, from its formation in 1958 until its elimination on February 1, 2012, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego (Former RDA) administered the implementation of various redevelopment projects, programs, and activities within designated redevelopment project areas throughout the City of San Diego (City); and

WHEREAS, the Former RDA dissolved as of February 1, 2012, in accordance with a deadline for elimination of all redevelopment agencies throughout California set forth in Assembly Bill x1 26 (AB 26), as modified by the California Supreme Court in *California Redevelopment Assn. v. Matosantos*, 53 Cal.4th 231 (2011); and

WHEREAS, at the time of the Former RDA's dissolution, the City, in its capacity as the Successor Agency to the Former RDA (Successor Agency), became vested with all of the Former RDA's authority, rights, powers, duties, and obligations under the California Community Redevelopment Law and, by operation of law, received all assets, properties, contracts, leases, books and records, buildings, and equipment of the Former RDA; and

WHEREAS, the Successor Agency is winding down the Former RDA's affairs in accordance with AB 26, enacted on June 28, 2011, and subsequent legislation; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. R-309274 and Resolution No. R-309248, both passed on October 8, 2014, the City and the Successor Agency entered into that certain Agreement Regarding Expenditure of Excess Redevelopment Bond Proceeds dated November

14, 2014, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-309247 (Bond Expenditure Agreement), which provides for the Successor Agency's transfer of excess non-housing bond proceeds to the City and the City's expenditure of such bond proceeds in accordance with the Bond Spending Plan included as Exhibit 2 to the Bond Expenditure Agreement (Bond Spending Plan); and

WHEREAS, the El Cajon Boulevard Pedestrian Improvements Project (Project) will repair and install sidewalks within the Crossroads community boundaries; and

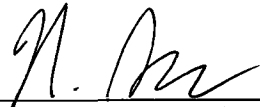
WHEREAS, the Bond Spending Plan identifies the Project as one of the activities to be implemented by the City using Bond Expenditure Agreement funds now in the City's possession; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the Capital Improvements Program Annual Allocation AIK-00003, Sidewalk Repair & Replacement (B-15210 – El Cajon Boulevard Pedestrian Improvement Project), and to appropriate and expend a total amount not to exceed \$1,190,423.54, consisting of \$1,130,423.54 from Fund 400696 – 2010A (TE) Crossroads Bond Proceeds, and \$60,000 from Fund 200700 – RPTTF (ROPS line item 467) solely and exclusively for the Project, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing a certificate certifying that all funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

2. Council Policy 800-14, Prioritizing Capital Improvement Program Projects, is hereby waived.
