A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT APPROVAL OF THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO LEASE FOR ADDITIONAL OFFICE SPACE AT 9370 CHESAPEAKE DRIVE, SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15301.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) currently leases office space from Ruffin-SD, LLC, a California limited liability company (Lessor) in Suite 100 of the building located at 9370 Chesapeake Drive, San Diego, California (Lease). The adjoining space identified as Suite 150 ("Expansion Space"), previously occupied and used as office space by another tenant, has become available and the City has negotiated a Second Amendment to the Lease to expand its use of office space under the Lease to include the Expansion Space (Project); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (California Public Resources Code sections 21000-21177), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, section 15000, *et seq.*) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 (Existing

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Facilities) and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEOA Guidelines

section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) has considered the

potential environmental effects of the Project, and

WHEREAS, on November 17, 2015, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting

and considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the

Project will not have a significant effect on the environment because it involves the leasing of an

existing private structure and/or facility, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that

existing at the time of the determination; and NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego determines that the Project

is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 (Existing

Facilities), and that an exception to the exemption does not apply.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council has determined that an exception

to the exemption as set forth in CEOA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
