AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 7, DIVISION 1 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING NEW SECTION 27.0121; AND AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 7, DIVISION 27 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 27.2719, RELATING TO THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ELECTION CODE ORDINANCE AND RECALL

WHEREAS, article XI, section 5(a) of the California Constitution provides that a charter city may "make and enforce all ordinances and regulations in respect to municipal affairs," and that "[c]ity charters adopted pursuant to this Constitution shall supersede any existing charter, and with respect to municipal affairs shall supersede all laws inconsistent therewith"; and

WHEREAS, article XI, section 5(b) grants plenary authority to charter cities to provide laws in their charters for the "conduct of city elections"; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Charter thus governs City elections and Charter section 8 requires the City Council to adopt an election code ordinance, "providing an adequate and complete procedure to govern municipal elections"; and

WHEREAS, the Council adopted an election code ordinance in the San Diego Municipal Code that includes general provisions related to all City elections, at Chapter 2, Article 7, Division 1, sections 27.0101 to 27.0120; and

WHEREAS, Charter section 23 sets forth the percentage of registered voters who must sign a petition to place a recall measure on the ballot, and requires the Council to include in the election code ordinance an "expeditious and complete procedure for the exercise by the people of the . . . recall"; and

WHEREAS, the election code ordinance in the San Diego Municipal Code includes a chapter detailing the City's recall procedures at Chapter 2, Article 7, Division 27, sections 27.2701 through 27.2729; and

WHEREAS, the Council now desires to amend two of the election-related Municipal Code sections, with one section added to specify the time of the filing deadline for papers filed with the City Clerk's Office, and one section being amended to bring the procedure for withdrawal of signatures from a recall petition into uniformity with similar provisions related to initiative and referendum petitions; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 2, Article 7, Division 1 of the San Diego Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding new section 27.0121 as follows:

### **Division 1: Elections - General**

## §27.0121 Filings Due to Clerk by Close of Business

A petition or report required by this article to be filed with the *Clerk* must be submitted for filing to the *Clerk* by the close of business at 5 p.m. on the day of its filing.

Section 2. That Chapter 2, Article 7, Division 27 is amended by amending section 27.2719 as follows:

#### **Division 27: Recall**

### §27.2719 Withdrawal of Signature

Any *voter* signing a *petition* shall have his or her signature withdrawn from the *petition* if the *voter* files with the *Clerk* a written request to withdraw the signature, bearing his or her name, address, and signature, before the *petition* is

filed with the *Clerk*. In order to be valid, the withdrawal request must also be received by the *Clerk* on or after the date the *voter* signed the *petition*. Once the *petition* is filed with the *Clerk*, no signatures may be withdrawn.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
