AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO AUTHORIZE THE SEVENTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT WITH AECOM TECHNICAL SERVICES, INC. FOR THE LA JOLLA VILLAGE DRIVE/I-805 AND MIRAMAR ROAD WIDENING PROJECT.

WHEREAS, on March 29, 2002 the City and AECOM Technical Services [AECOM] executed a consultant agreement to provide professional services related to the improvement of the La Jolla Village Drive and Interstate 805 Interchange and related improvements to Miramar Road; and

WHEREAS, this consultant agreement has subsequently been amended on January 28, 2003 (1st Amendment), May 10, 2004 (2nd Amendment), October 24, 2006 (3rd Amendment), December 4, 2007 (4th Amendment), September 16, 2008 (5th Amendment), and October 11, 2011 (6th Amendment); and

WHEREAS, the City and AECOM now desire to execute a 7th Amendment for an extension of time to the Agreement in order to complete Phase II of Miramar Road Widening Project; and

WHEREAS, under San Diego Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by ordinance adopted by a two-thirds' majority vote of the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, the Seventh Amendment to the Agreement with AECOM for the purpose of an extension of time for CIP S-00857 and CIP S-0880, La Jolla Village Drive/I-805 and Miramar

Road Widening under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- **20614**.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
