AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 4, DIVISION 5 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 24.0501, RELATING TO THE CITY EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, section 24.0501 subparagraph (d) of the San Diego Municipal Code (Municipal Code) states that a Member employed by the City as of July 1, 2000 who suffered a violent attack at work resulting in great bodily harm to the Member, is eligible for an industrial disability retirement benefit for a resulting mental or nervous disorder that renders the Member permanently incapable of performing his or her normal and customary duties; and

WHEREAS, for a Member not represented by the Police Officers' Association (POA) to receive this benefit, the attack must have occurred before July 1, 2005; and

WHEREAS, for a Member represented by the Police Officers' Association (POA) to receive this benefit, Municipal Code section 24.0501(d) states that the attack must have occurred before July 1, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) agreed in the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City and the POA for Fiscal Year 2009 (FY 2009 MOU), to extend the benefit in Municipal Code section 24.0501(d) through June 30, 2010, after which no further applications for the benefit will be accepted; and

WHEREAS, the City never took steps to amend Municipal Code section 24.0501(d) to extend the benefit for Members represented by the POA from July 1, 2003, until the agreed-upon sunset date of June 30, 2010; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance extends the sunset of the benefit set forth in Municipal Code section 24.0501(d) through June 30, 2010 to conform to the FY 2009 MOU; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance also includes amendments that do not affect the benefits of any Member, but are intended to make Municipal Code section 24.0501 consistent with other provisions of the retirement plan; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 2, Article 4, Division 4 of the San Diego Municipal Code is amended by amending section 24.0501 as follows:

## Article 4: City Employees' Retirement System

### **Division 5: Disability Retirements**

## §24.0501 Industrial Disability—Safety and General Members

- (a) Any *Member* who joined the *System* on or before September 3, 1982, is eligible for an industrial disability retirement allowance, regardless of his or her age or years of *Service Credit*, if:
  - (1) the *Member* is permanently incapacitated from the performance of duty,
  - (2) the *Member's* incapacity is the result of injury or disease arising out of or in the course of his or her *City* employment, and
  - (3) the *Member's* incapacity renders his or her retirement necessary.
- (b) Any *Member* who enrolled in the *System* after September 3, 1982 will receive an industrial disability retirement allowance, regardless of his or her age or years of *Service Credit*, if:
  - (1) the *Member* is permanently incapacitated from the performance of duty,
  - (2) the *Member's* incapacity is the result of injury or disease arising out of or in the course of his or her *City* employment,

- (3) the *Member's* incapacity renders his or her retirement necessary, and
- (4) the *Member's* incapacity did not arise from:
  - (A) a preexisting medical condition, or
  - (B) a nervous or mental disorder.
- For purposes of section 24.0501, a preexisting medical condition is a condition that occurred or existed before the *Member* joined the *System*.
   Any medical condition that occurs during a mandatory waiting period before the *Member* is eligible to join the *System* is not a preexisting condition.
- (d) Despite section 24.0501(b)(4), a *Member* who is employed by the *City* as of July 1, 2000 is eligible for an industrial disability retirement if all of the following conditions are met:
  - (1) the *Member* is a victim of a violent attack involving the use of deadly force,
  - (2) the attack occurs after June 30, 2000,
  - (3) the attack occurs before July 1, 2010, if the *Member* is in the Police Officers' Association bargaining unit, or before July 1, 2005, for all other *Members*,
  - (4) the attack occurs while the *Member* is performing his or her duties as a *City* employee,
  - (5) the attack causes the *Member* great bodily harm,
  - (6) the attack causes the *Member* to suffer a nervous or mental disorder, and

(7) the *Board* determines, based upon the medical evidence, that the *Member* has become psychologically or mentally incapable of performing his or her normal and customary duties, as a result of the attack.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.

# §24.0501 Industrial Disability—Safety and General Members

- (a) Any Member Member who joined the Retirement System System on or before September 3, 1982, is eligible for an industrial disability retirement allowance, regardless of his or her age or Creditable Service years of Service Credit, if:
  - (1) the <u>Member-Member</u> is permanently incapacitated from the performance of duty,
  - (2) the Member's <u>Member's</u> incapacity is the result of injury or disease arising out of or in the course of his or her <u>City City</u> employment, and
  - (3) the <u>Member's Member's incapacity renders his or her retirement</u> necessary.

- (b) Any Member Member who enrolled in the Retirement System System after September 3, 1982 will receive an industrial disability retirement allowance, regardless of his or her age or Creditable Service years of Service Credit, if:
  - (1) the <u>Member Member</u> is permanently incapacitated from the performance of duty,
  - (2) the Member's incapacity is the result of injury or disease arising out of or in the course of his or her <u>City</u> employment,
  - (3) the Member's <u>Member's</u> incapacity renders his or her retirement necessary, and
  - (4) the <u>Member's Member's incapacity</u> did not arise from:
    - (A) a preexisting medical condition, or
    - (B) a nervous or mental disorder.
- (c) For purposes of section 24.0501, a preexisting medical condition is a condition that occurred or existed before the <u>Member Member</u> joined the <u>Retirement System System</u>. Any medical condition that occurs during a mandatory waiting period before the <u>Member Member</u> is eligible to join the <u>Retirement System System</u> is not a preexisting condition.
- (d) Despite section 24.0501(b)(4), a <u>Member-Member</u> who is employed by the City-City as of July 1, 2000 is eligible for an industrial disability retirement if all of the following conditions are met:

(2) the attack occurs on or after July 1 June 30, 2000,

(3) the attack occurs before July 1, 2003-2010. if the Member Member

is in the Police Officers' Association bargaining unit, or before

July 1, 2005, for all other Members-Members,

(4) the attack occurs while the <u>Member Member</u> is performing his or

her duties as a City City employee,

(5) the attack causes the Member Member great bodily harm,

(6) the attack causes the <u>Member Member</u> to suffer a nervous or

mental disorder, and

(7) the <u>Board Board</u> determines, based upon the medical evidence,

that the Member Member has become psychologically or mentally

incapable of performing his or her normal and customary duties, as

a result of the attack.
