DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUL 14 2016

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE CONSULTANT AGREEMENT WITH AECOM TECHNICAL SERVICES FOR THE SORRENTO VALLEY-INTERSTATE 5 INTERCHANGE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City and AECOM Technical Services, Inc. entered into a Consultant Agreement to provide design services for the Sorrento Valley – Interstate 5 Interchange Project, as approved by Council Resolution No. R-304010, dated August 6, 2008; the First Amendment to Agreement Ordinance No. O-20416, dated September 30, 2014; and

WHEREAS, potential alternatives to alleviate traffic congestion in the Sorrento Valley and Interstate 5 Interchange consist of substantial infrastructure improvements including the relocation of the existing Coaster rail station and the construction of a rail-grade separation at Sorrento Valley Road/Sorrento Valley Blvd ; and

WHEREAS, the Second Amendment to the Agreement will provide for the preparation of a report on potential transit-supportive development scenarios to support the Sorrento Valley Road/Sorrento Valley Boulevard improvements associated with relocating the current Coaster Station, which includes land valuation estimates, and funding strategies; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a second amendment to the consultant agreement with AECOM Technical Services, Inc., for preliminary engineering design in CIP S-00914, Sorrento Valley Road & Interstate 5 Interchange, in an amount not to exceed \$71,360.00, under the terms and conditions set forth in


the Second Amendment to Agreement on file with the City Clerk as Document No. OO-
2066.2

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$71,360.00 from S-00914, Sorrento Valley Road & Interstate 5 Interchange, Fund No. 400169, Transnet Extension 7, for the purposes of executing this Second Amendment to the Agreement.

Section 3. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its final passage.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
