

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 20670 (NEW SERIES)

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUL 11 2016

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2016, AND CONSOLIDATING THE MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION WITH THE CALIFORNIA STATE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE SAME DATE.

WHEREAS, San Diego Charter section 10 provides that, commencing with the year 1996, the Municipal General Elections for the offices of Councilmember for Districts 1, 3, 5, and 7 shall be held on the same date in each election year as the California State General Election; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Charter section 10 provides that, commencing with the year 2012, the Municipal General Election for the office of Councilmember for District 9 also shall be held on the same date in each election year as the other odd-numbered districts, and as the California State General Election; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Charter section 10 also directs that, commencing with the year 1984, elections to the offices of Mayor and City Attorney shall be held every four years, with the Municipal General Elections to those offices to be held on the same date in each election year as the California State General Election; and

WHEREAS, in the year 2016, the California State General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2016; and

WHEREAS, calling the Municipal General Election for the same date as the California State General Election is mandated by San Diego Charter section 10 and, therefore, is not subject to veto by the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, at a meeting held on JUL 11, 2016, the City Council of the City of San Diego passed Resolution Number R- 310583, requesting that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego approve the consolidation of the Municipal General Election to be held on November 8, 2016 with the California State General Election to be held on the same date; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Charter section 10 also provides that, in the event one candidate has received the majority of votes cast for all candidates for nomination to a particular elective office in the Municipal Primary Election, that the candidate shall be deemed to be, and declared by the Council to be, elected to such office; and, if not, the top two vote-getters will advance to a Municipal General Election; and

WHEREAS, for the following offices, a candidate received the majority of votes cast for all candidates for nomination in the Municipal Primary Election, and thus there will not be runoff elections for these offices: Mayor, Councilmember for District 3, Councilmember for District 5, and Councilmember for District 7; and

WHEREAS, for the following offices, no candidate received a majority of votes cast for all candidates for nomination in the Municipal Primary Election, and thus the top two vote-getters for these offices will advance to the Municipal General Election: City Attorney, Councilmember for District 1 and Councilmember for District 9; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby ordered that a Municipal General Election will be held in the City of San Diego on Tuesday, November 8, 2016, for the purpose of electing candidates for the following offices:


Section 5. The polls for this Municipal General Election shall be open from 7:00 a.m. on November 8, 2016, and remain open continuously until 8:00 p.m. on the same day. The polls shall close at 8:00 p.m., except as provided in California Elections Code section 14401.

Section 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause this ordinance to be published once in the official newspaper of the City of San Diego.

Section 7. A full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 8. Pursuant to San Diego Charter sections 275(c), 295(b) and 295(d), this ordinance relating to elections may be passed by the City Council on the date of introduction, which date shall be deemed the date of final passage, and is not subject to veto by the Mayor.
