DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUL 1 9 2016

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A MASTER LEASE AGREEMENT WITH BANC OF AMERICA PUBLIC CAPITAL CORP. FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING THE ACQUISITION OF AN INFRASTRUCTURE ASSET MANAGEMENT SYSTEM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$10,000,000, AND TAKING OTHER ACTIONS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, from time to time the City of San Diego (City) needs to acquire projects and equipment for the purpose of providing public services and frequently uses lease-purchase financing to purchase such projects and equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor recommends entering into a Master Lease Agreement (Agreement) with BAPCC in an amount not to exceed \$10,000,000 to finance the implementation of the IAM System through a lease-purchase arrangement; and

WHEREAS, the IAM System is described in more detail in Report to City Council No. 16-062, dated June 8, 2016 (Report); and

WHEREAS, under San Diego Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by an ordinance adopted by a two-thirds majority of the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized and directed to finance the cost of implementing the IAM System using a Master Lease Agreement with BAPCC.

That the Mayor, the Chief Operating Officer, the Chief Financial Officer Section 2.

or any of their designees is hereby authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the

City of San Diego, a Master Lease Agreement with BAPCC for the purpose of financing the

implementation of the IAM System. The Master Lease Agreement shall be substantially in the

form presented to this Council, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No.

20691 with such additions and changes therein as the Chief Operating Officer or

Chief Financial Officer, in consultation with the City Attorney, shall approve as being in the best

interest of the City; provided however that: (i) the acquisition cost of projects and equipment

financed under the Master Lease Agreement shall not exceed \$10,000,000; (ii) the interest rate

shall not exceed six percent (6%) annually; and (iii) the lease term of the Master Lease

Agreement shall not exceed 7 years.

That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a Section 3.

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day Section 4.
