AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO EXEMPTING THREE PROGRAM COORDINATOR POSITIONS IN THE CITY TREASURER'S OFFICE FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on September 1, 2016, the City of San Diego (City)'s Civil Service

Commission reviewed a request from the City Treasurer's Office (Department) to exempt three

Program Coordinator positions from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, these positions will assist in the administration and enforcement of the City's new Earned Sick Leave and Minimum Wage Ordinance (ESL & MW Ordinance), under the direction of the ESL & MW Ordinance Program Manager; and

WHEREAS, the Program Coordinator Positions will assist in the development of policies and procedures for the ESL & MW Ordinance Enforcement Office; conduct outreach to educate business owners and community groups; evaluate all complaints received and determine if a Notice of Violation needs to be issued; conduct field investigations and prepare documentary evidence; facilitate settlement conferences, negotiate penalties, or make a determination to go directly to an independent hearing officer; and prepare reports and presentations for distribution to management and the City Council; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Charter (Charter) section 117(a)(17) states that the Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council"; and

WHEREAS, on September 1, 2016, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the Program Coordinator positions, as provided by the Department, the Civil Service Commission determined that the Program Coordinator positions meet the standard set forth in Charter section 117(a)(17) to be placed in the Unclassified Service; and

WHEREAS, the determinations of the Civil Service Commission are set forth in a memorandum dated September 2, 2016, from Hadi Dehghani, Personnel Director, to the Honorable Council President and City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council has received and reviewed a memorandum from Personnel Director Hadi Dehghani, dated September 2, 2016, which documents that, on September 1, 2016, the City's Civil Service Commission reviewed and favorably commented on a proposal from the Department to exempt three Program Coordinator positions from the Classified Service. The Program Coordinator positions will assist in the development of policies and procedures for the ESL & MW Ordinance Enforcement Office; conduct outreach to educate business owners and community groups; evaluate all complaints received and determine if a Notice of Violation needs to be issued; conduct field investigations and prepare documentary evidence; facilitate settlement conferences, negotiate penalties, or make a determination to go directly to an independent hearing officer; and prepare reports and presentations for distribution to management and the City Council.

Section 2. That pursuant to Charter section 117(a)(17), with the Civil Service Commission's review and approval, the City Council exempts from the Classified Service and declares to be in the Unclassified Service of the City three Program Coordinator positions, performing the duties set forth in the September 2, 2016, memorandum from Personnel Director Hadi Dehghani to the Honorable Council President and City Council, and in this ordinance.

Section 3. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to passage, a written copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
