A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE FROM CALTRANS OF RELINQUISHED RIGHT-OF-WAY, AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF ALL OTHER NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS RELATED TO THE RELINQUISHMENT, FOR THE STATE ROUTE 163/FRIARS ROAD INTERCHANGE MODIFICATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City), in coordination with the California

Department of Transportations (Caltrans) and the Federal Highway Administration, proposed improvements to portions of the State Route 163/Friars Road interchange and adjacent streets (the Project); all phases of the Project's work are located in the central portion of Mission Valley, centered around the interchange of the eight-lane, north-south trending State Route 163 freeway, with the six-lane, east-west local street, Friars Road; also affected in Phase I of the Project are Frazee Road, Ulric Street and Avenida de las Tiendas; and

WHEREAS, Phase I of the Project is intended to relieve frequent and severe congestion which is primarily due to adjacent residential development, traffic generated by the adjacent shopping centers, and the Project's close proximity to the State Route 163/I-8 freeway-to-freeway interchange; and

WHEREAS, major elements of Phase I of the Project include the widening of Friars

Road bridge, the widening and/or restriping of other roads and freeway ramps, the relocation of medians and modification of various traffic movements, and the minimization of adverse effects on current circulation during the Project's construction activities; and

WHEREAS, in order to widen Friars Road and reconfigure the existing interchange

ramps at State Route 163, it is necessary to acquire, transfer and relinquish right-of-way through

the Project corridor to comply with current City and Caltrans standards; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his

designee(s), are authorized to accept the relinquishment of certain Caltrans' right-of-way shown

as "SEGMENT 1" on the attached EXHIBIT A, which right-of-way is needed to widen Friars

Road and reconfigure the existing interchange ramps at State Route 163.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee(s), are authorized to

execute any and all documents that are necessary and appropriate to effectuate the above City

Council-authorized acceptance of the Caltrans right-of-way.


