A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DENYING THE APPEAL AND ADOPTING THE MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION AND MITIGATION, MONITORING, AND REPORTING PROGRAM FOR VIA DEL MAR ESTATES – PROJECT NO. 347254.

WHEREAS, Thomas J. Kelley, Trustee of Thomas J. Kelly Separate Property Trust dated October 28, 2013, Owner/Permittee, filed an application with the City of San Diego for a permit to subdivide the property into four lots and construct four single family residences; and

WHEREAS, the 5.07-acre Via Del Mar Estates project site is located to the south and west of Via Del Mar Road and north of Arroyo Sorrento Road within the Neighborhood 8b Precise Plan area within the Carmel Valley Community Plan area; and

WHEREAS, the project site is designated Rural Residential within the Carmel Valley Community Plan and is zoned AR-1-2, and is currently vacant undeveloped land; and

WHEREAS, the surrounding properties are partially developed rural residential properties within a rural area of Carmel Valley; and

WHEREAS, the site contains steep hillsides and sensitive biological resources and therefore, is subject to the Environmentally Sensitive Lands (ESL) Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Analysis Section of the Development Services

Department prepared Mitigated Negative Declaration No. 347254 for the project in accordance with the State California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, a Mitigation, Monitoring, and Reporting Program has been prepared and will be implemented, which will reduce the potential impacts to Biological Resources, Historical Resources (Archaeology) and Paleontological Resources to a level below significance; and

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2015, the Planning Commission adopted Mitigated

Negative Declaration No. 347254 and the Mitigation, Monitoring, and Reporting Program, and

approved the project; and

WHEREAS, on September 22, 2015, an appeal of the approval of the Mitigated Negative

Declaration was filed by Theresa Quiroz; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 280(a)(2), this resolution is not subject to veto by the

Mayor because this matter requires the City Council to act as a quasi-judicial body and where a

public hearing was required by law implicating due process rights of individuals affected by the

decision and where the Council was required by law to consider evidence at the hearing and to

make legal findings based on the evidence presented; and

WHEREAS, the appeal was heard before the City Council on January 19, 2016,

testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted, and the City Council having fully

considered the matter being fully advised concerning the same; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the appeal is

hereby denied and the Mitigated Negative Declaration and Mitigation, Monitoring, and

Reporting Program No. 347254 are adopted.
