RESOLUTION DENYING AN APPEAL AND UPHOLDING THE ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION FOR THE KAPLAN-GASTON RESIDENCE (PROJECT NO. 331559).

WHEREAS, an application was submitted for a Coastal Development Permit to remodel and add 884 square feet to an existing 1,559 square-foot single-family residence located at 5606 Dolphin Place (Project); and

WHEREAS, on July 24, 2015, the Environmental Analysis Section of the Development Services Department determined the project to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 (Existing Facilities) and a Notice of Right to Appeal Environmental Determination was posted; and

WHEREAS, on August 7, 2015, Julie Hamilton, representing Richard Kruse, filed an Environmental Determination Appeal Application (Appeal) with the City's Development Services Department stating that the environmental determination was based on factual error, conflicted with other matters, was not supported by the findings, and was subject to new information; and

WHEREAS, the appellant and applicant subsequently worked together to revise the underlying Project, and appellant withdrew the Appeal; and

WHEREAS, the Appeal was heard before the City Council on January 26, 2016; and

WHERAS, a Notice of Exemption has not yet been filed for the Project and will only be filed after Project approval; and

WHEREAS, approval of the Project would not result in a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Project is exempt under CEQA Guidelines Sections 15301; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 280(a)(2) this resolution is not subject to veto by the Mayor because this matter requires the City Council to act as a quasi-judicial body and where a public hearing was required by law implicating due process rights of individuals affected by the decision and where the Council was required by law to consider evidence at the hearing and to make legal findings based on the evidence presented; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Appeal is hereby denied and the environmental determination is upheld.
