WHEREAS, an application was submitted for a Conditional Use Permit for a communication switching station located at 4020 Convoy Street (Project); and

WHEREAS, on October 30, 2015, the Environmental Analysis Section of the Development Services Department determined the Project to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Sections 15301 (Existing Facilities) and 15303 (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures) and a Notice of Right to Appeal Environmental Determination was posted; and

WHEREAS, on November 13, 2015, Tim Nguyen and Wesley Quach filed an Environmental Determination Appeal Application (Appeal); and

WHEREAS, the Appeal was heard before the City Council on February 2, 2015; and WHEREAS, the Project involves demolishing an existing commercial building and constructing and approximate 6,238-square-foot, unmanned communication switching station on a 0.50-acre site; and

WHEREAS, the site is currently developed with an existing market/restaurant building which has been vacant since 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Project is located on a site zoned for its use where all necessary public services and facilities are available, and is not located in an environmentally sensitive area; and

WHEREAS, approval of the Project would not result in a significant effect on the

environment; and

WHEREAS, the Project is exempt under CEQA Guidelines Sections 15301 and 15303;

and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 280(a)(2), this resolution is not subject to veto by the

public hearing was required by law implicating due process rights of individuals affected by the

decision and where the Council was required by law to consider evidence at the hearing and to

hereby denied and the environmental determination is upheld.
