A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE APPROVAL OF THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND ACE PARKING III, LLC FOR PARKING MANAGEMENT SERVICES AND AUTOMATED PARKING SYSTEM UPGRADE FOR THE EVAN V. JONES PARKADE IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15301.

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) desires to authorize the Management Services and Construction of Fully Automated Parking Garage Agreement with Ace Parking III, LLC, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 310248, for the management and the automated parking system upgrade of the Evan V. Jones Parkade (Project); and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 and that no

exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the

Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential

environmental effects of the Project, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego held a duly noticed public meeting and

considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has

determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment; NOW

THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent

judgement, has considered the written record and public comment for the requested

authorization, and determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEOA pursuant to

CEQA Guidelines section 15301 and that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA

Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
