A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO APPROVE AND EXECUTE A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE ORIGINAL GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA WILDLIFE CONSERVATION BOARD AND RIVER PARTNERS FOR THE SAN DIEGUITO RIPARIAN RESTORATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Water Fund owns 8,600 acres in the San Pasqual Valley, located thirty miles north of downtown San Diego and the Public Utilities Department manages this land for water resources as an agricultural preserve as part of the City of San Diego's (City) Multi-Habitat Preserve Area; and

WHEREAS, the San Dieguito River Riparian Restoration Project (Project) has the goals of restoring self-sustaining native riparian environment along the San Dieguito River, providing stewardship of natural resources, including the protection of threatened and endangered species, enhancing source water protection for Hodges Reservoir and providing recreational opportunities for the public; and

WHEREAS, the Project will benefit San Diego's water system by providing water quality protection to Hodges Reservoir, which is owned by Public Utilities and is a key feature of the regional water supply system; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute the First Amendment to the original Grant Agreement with the Wildlife Conservation Board of the State of California, the City of San Diego and River Partners, to take effect retroactively as of July 3, 2014.

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2. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute future amendments to

the original Grant Agreement as necessary to administer the Project, and to take all necessary

actions to implement the Project.

3. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute a five year Right-of-

Entry permit to River Partners.

4. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute a no-cost, Landowner

Agreement to confirm the City's obligation under its Multiple Species Conservation Program to

establish that the terms, conditions and restrictions of the original Grant Agreement with the

State/Wildlife Conservation Board and River Partners are binding upon and inure to the benefit

of the City and its respective personal representatives, heirs, successors, and assigns, and shall

continue as a servitude running for the Project's life span on the subject lands.

5. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend \$10,050 each year for

four years, beginning in FY 2016, for a total amount not to exceed \$40,200, from Water Utility

Operating Fund 700011, for the City's cost-share of this project, contingent upon adoption of the

Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal years, and contingent upon the City

Comptroller first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for

expenditures are, or will be on deposit with the City Treasurer.
