DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAR 23 2016

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING \$1,800 TO THE EL CAJON BOULEVARD BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION FOR THE MID CITY I-805 HOLIDAY BRIDGE LIGHTS, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-06, "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES."

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-06, titled "City Council Funding of Community Projects, Programs and Services" on June 28, 2011, by San Diego Resolution R-306903 (July 7, 2011); and

WHEREAS, among other things, Council Policy 100-06 provides a procedure and uniform requirements for awarding funds to and contracting with non-profit organizations and public agencies for one-time community, social, environmental, cultural, or recreational needs which serve a lawful public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the El Cajon Boulevard Business Improvement Association has requested funding for the Mid-City I-805 Holiday Bridge Lights; and

WHEREAS, the requested funding will be used to continue the holiday lighting display for the Mid-City area and for the four business improvement districts and the business communities along Adams Avenue, El Cajon Boulevard, and University Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the El Cajon Boulevard Business Improvement Association's request for funding for the Mid-City I-805 Holiday Bridge Lights will benefit the 2 million freeway users and another 1.3 million that traverse the bridges on the surface streets, promoting business, tourism and residence in the Mid-City area; and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described program fits within the parameters of Council Policy 100-06; and

WHEREAS, Council District 3 recommends an allocation of \$1,800 to the El Cajon Boulevard Business Improvement Association for the purposes set forth in this resolution; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocation described in this resolution is made for a public purpose.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 3(g), which provides: "An organization may not apply to receive funding for an event or program which has already occurred, nor any capital improvement, goods, supplies, materials, or equipment which have already been purchased."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a Community Projects, Programs, and Services FY 2016 City Council Allocations Agreement between the City of San Diego and the El Cajon Boulevard Business Improvement Association (Agreement) in an amount not to exceed \$1,800 for the project described in this resolution, under terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 310304.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$1,800 from the Community Projects, Programs, and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost Center 1103110003, CD 3, to provide funds for the above-referenced





