A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN THE AMOUNT AUTHORIZED FOR THE CONTRACT FOR SYSTEMS FURNITURE AND RELATED SERVICES WITH GM BUSINESS INTERIORS.

WHEREAS, in 2013, the City Council authorized City staff to enter into an agreement with GM Business Interiors (GMBI) using a cooperative contract for systems furniture and related services in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000 (San Diego Resolution R-308397 (Aug. 5, 2013)); and

WHEREAS, the City Council amended San Diego Municipal Code section 22.3206 in 2015 to authorize expenditures up to \$3,000,000 without City Council approval; and

WHEREAS, City staff erroneously interpreted this amendment to allow an expenditure of up to \$3,000,000 on the City's contract with GMBI; and

WHEREAS, City staff should have returned to Council to request authorization to expend more than the \$2,000,000 previously approved and, having caught the error, now seek retroactive approval of this expenditure; and

WHEREAS, on February 2, 2016, the Purchasing and Contracting Director approved a request from the Real Estate Assets Department for a sole source contract award to GMBI on the ground that the City utilizes the Herman Miller brand in many City departments, that Herman Miller furniture is not compatible with other furniture brands, and that GMBI is the sole authorized representative of Herman Miller office furniture in San Diego County; and

WHEREAS, City staff seeks authorization to spend an additional \$4,630,000 for additional system furniture design, new system furniture, and installation services through FY

17, and a reserve amount to pay for unscheduled moves throughout the City due to unforeseen

operational needs; and

WHEREAS, City staff requests authorization to expend up to \$7,630,000 on this

contract; and

WHEREAS, City staff have determined that this activity is not a project and is therefore

not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines

section 15060(c)(3); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his

designee, is authorized to increase the value of this contract to a not- to-exceed amount of

\$7,630,000 to be paid from the operating budgets of the City departments purchasing furniture

under the as-needed contract with GMBI, contingent upon the adoption upon the Chief Financial

Officer certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are or will be on deposit with the City

Treasurer.
