A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO PUBLIC EMERGENCY PROCEDURES ARE EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15061(B)(3).

WHEREAS, the Proposed Amendments to the San Diego Municipal Code Relating to Public Emergency Procedures (Proposed Amendments) seek to update the City's Municipal Code to better adapt it to current City government and also to have it work in harmony with federal and state emergency procedures laws; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), section 21083, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall specifically include criteria for public agencies to follow in determining whether or not a proposed project may have a "significant effect on the environment"; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department staff has exempted the Proposed Amendments from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3); and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the Proposed Amendments; and

WHEREAS, on APR 2 6 2016 , the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Proposed Amendments as well as any public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has determined that there is no possibility that the Proposed Amendments will have a significant effect on the environment because the Proposed Amendments do not authorize any activity that would have a physical impact; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Proposed Amendments to the San Diego Municipal Code Relating to Public Emergency Procedures are exempt from CEOA pursuant to CEOA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3).
