A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO WAIVING COUNCIL POLICY 000-21 AND DIRECTING PREPARATION OF A BALLOT MEASURE FOR CONSIDERATION FOR PLACEMENT ON THE NOVEMBER 2016 BALLOT.

WHEREAS, Council Policy 000-21 governs the procedure and schedule in which the San Diego City Council (Council) considers ballot measures proposed by members of the public, Councilmembers, the Mayor or mayoral departments, independent department directors, and public agencies for potential placement on an upcoming primary or general election ballot; and

WHEREAS, the Council expects to consider a large number of measures for potential placement on the November 2016 ballot; and

WHEREAS, the Council has the authority to waive a Council Policy for a specified purpose and wishes to waive Council Policy 000-21 so it may begin to discuss potential ballot measures and direct staff to prepare related ordinances earlier in the calendar year; and

WHEREAS, the Council cannot approve ballot measures for placement on the November 2016 ballot until the election has been called, an action that will occur after certification of the June 2016 primary election; and

WHEREAS, the Council also wishes to provide direction to the City Attorney's Office and to staff to begin preparing a ballot measure regarding amendments to Charter sections 32.1, Responsibility of Manager and Non-Managerial Officers to Report to Council, and 270(h), The Council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Charter sections 280(a)(1) and 295(b), the Council's actions

regarding the waiver of its own policy and direction to the City Attorney's Office to prepare a

proposed ballot measure are matters within its purview and are not subject to veto, and thus the

date of the passage of this resolution by the Council shall be deemed the date of its final passage;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that:

1. Council Policy 000-21 is hereby waived so that the Council may consider a

proposed ballot measure and direct preparation of an ordinance including that measure.

The City Attorney's Office is directed to conduct legal analysis and work with 2.

staff to prepare an ordinance including a potential ballot measure to amend Charter sections 32.1,

Responsibility of Manager and Non-Managerial Officers to Report to Council, and 270(h), The

Council, and related Charter sections as legally required, and return to Council for consideration

of the ordinance after the November 8, 2016 Municipal General Election has been called.
