RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 310388

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAY 04 2016

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATIONS TO CALRECYCLE FOR THE BEVERAGE CONTAINER RECYCLING CITY/COUNTY PAYMENT PROGRAM AND TAKING RELATED ACTIONS IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15308.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 14500 *et seq.*, the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) has established the Beverage Container Recycling City/County Payment Program to make payments available to support the beverage container recycling and litter cleanup activities of qualifying jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the City's submittal of applications to CalRecycle for the Beverage Container Recycling City/County Payment Program, and related actions, will allow the City to receive payments for the City's beverage container recycling and litter cleanup activities for Fiscal Year 2015/2016 through, and including, Fiscal Year 2019/2020 (Project); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 *et seq.*), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 *et seq.*) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and

adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15308, and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project, and


WHEREAS, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment as the Project consists of actions to secure funding that will support the City's beverage container recycling and litter cleanup activities, and thus will serve to maintain, restore, enhance, or protect the environment; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15308.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
