A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT FOR LEGAL SERVICES WITH GOMEZ TRIAL ATTORNEYS AND BARON & BUDD, P.C. IN CONNECTION WITH CLAIMS RELATED TO PRICE FIXING/ANTITRUST VIOLATIONS ON THE SALES OF FERRIC CHLORIDE, ALUMINUM SULFATE AND OTHER RELATED CHEMICALS BY KEMIRA CHEMICALS, INC. AND OTHER SIMILARLY SITUATED COMPANIES.

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, October 27, 2015, the U.S. Department of Justice announced that former executive Frank Reichl had pleaded guilty to conspiracy to eliminate market competition by fixing prices, rigging bids, and allocating customers for liquid aluminum sulfate supplied to municipalities; and

WHEREAS, Ferric chloride and aluminum sulfate are both chemicals used by municipalities to treat waste and drinking water by aggregating suspended solids prior to filtering; and

WHEREAS, the major companies which sell aluminum sulfate and ferric chloride include California Water Technologies, LLC, Phibro-Tech, Inc., PVS Chemicals, Inc. PVS Technologies, Inc., Kemira Chemicals, Inc. and Hawkins, Inc., and General Chemical Corporation, Reichl's company; and,

WHEREAS, these reported antitrust price-fixing, bid-fixing, and illegal client allocation practices may have artificially and illegally increased the price of ferric chloride, aluminum sulfate and other chemicals purchased by the City of San Diego, causing the City of San Diego to spend more money than it would have under normal market conditions.; and,

WHEREAS, Outside Counsel seeks a 25% contingency fee from the "gross recovery" as

defined in the legal services agreement and will advance costs and deduct those costs from any

"gross recovery"; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the San Diego City Attorney will retain complete control over

the conduct of the case; will retain a veto power over any decisions made by Outside Counsel; an

the Office of the San Diego City Attorney will assign an attorney with supervisory authority to

be personally involved in overseeing the litigation; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor or his

designee is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, the Agreement for Legal services

between the City of San Diego, Gomez Trial Attorneys, and Baron & Budd, P.C. in connection

with antitrust and other litigation against Kemira Chemicals, Inc. and any other provider of

Ferric Chloride or Aluminum Sulfate to the City of San Diego and any other companies or

persons involved in related antitrust activity.
