DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAY 23 2016

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING \$700 TO CITY HEIGHTS TOWN COUNCIL, INC. FOR THE RIDGVIEW NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION FALL BLOCK PARTY, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-06, "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES."

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-06, titled "City Council Funding of Community Projects, Programs and Services" on June 28, 2011, by San Diego Resolution R-306903 (July 7, 2011); and

WHEREAS, among other things, Council Policy 100-06 provides a procedure and uniform requirements for awarding funds to and contracting with non-profit organizations and public agencies for one-time community, social, environmental, cultural, or recreational needs which serve a lawful public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City Heights Town Council, Inc. has requested funding for the Ridgeview Neighborhood Association Fall Block Party; and

WHEREAS, the requested funding will be used to cover permits and security services required for the Fall Block Party; and

WHEREAS, the City Heights Town Council, Inc.'s request for funding for the Ridgeview Neighborhood Association Fall Block Party will benefit the public by building relationships among neighbors and celebrating their neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the above-described program fits within the parameters of Council Policy 100-06; and

WHEREAS, Council District 9 recommends an allocation of \$700 to the City Heights Town Council for the purposes set forth in this resolution; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocation described in this resolution is made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 3(g), which provides: “An organization may not apply to receive funding for an event or program which has already occurred, nor any capital improvement, goods, supplies, materials, or equipment which have already been purchased.”

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council waives Council Policy 100-06, section 8, which provides: “Community Projects, Programs and Services funding should be considered a one-time resource, and planned uses should be one-time in nature, to avoid service interruptions or employee impacts if funding is discontinued.”


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a Community Projects, Programs, and Services FY 2016 City Council Allocations Agreement between the City of San Diego and the City Heights Town Council, Inc. (Agreement) in an amount not to exceed \$700 for the project described in this resolution, under terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 310471.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$700 from the Community Projects, Programs, and Services budget Fund No. 100000, Cost Center 1109110009, CD 9, to provide funds for the above-referenced Agreement, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates

certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City

Treasurer.
