A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR AND/OR DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND EXECUTE A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE U.S. BUREAU OF RECLAMATION UNDER THE BAY-DELTA RESTORATION PROGRAM: CALFED WATER USE EFFICIENCY GRANTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016 FOR FUNDING OF THE ADVANCED METERING INFRASTRUCTURE.

WHEREAS, the Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) Project technology allows water meters to be read electronically rather than through direct visual inspection by field staff, and AMI data identifies and alerts staff and customers of unusual consumption patterns which could indicate leaks or meter tampering on a customer's property; and

WHEREAS, the initial AMI Project implementation which was approved by City Council in November 2012 (R-307885), installed a fixed network system and AMI devices on approximately 11,000 meters, and citywide deployment of the AMI Project will include approximately 270,000 additional bimonthly meters that cover all customer classes throughout San Diego at an estimated total cost of \$60,046,060; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to obtain supplemental funding for this project, the City proposes to apply for federal grant funds from the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation Bay-Delta Restoration Program: CALFED Water Use Efficiency Grant for the AMI installation of 270,000 additional meters, along with the supporting fixed data collection network and data processing systems; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by Ordinance approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the Mayor and/or designee is authorized to apply for, accept, and execute a

grant application to the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation under the Bay-Delta Restoration Program:

CALFED Water Use Efficiency Grants for Fiscal Year 2016 for funding of the Advanced

Metering Infrastructure (AMI) Project in an amount not to exceed \$750,000.

2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate and expend

\$750,000 from the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation Bay-Delta Restoration Program: CALFED Water

Use Efficiency Grant for the AMI Project if grant funding is secured.

3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-

bearing account for the grant, if required.

4. That the City Auditor and Comptroller, upon advice from the administering

department, is authorized to transfer excess funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.
