A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE APPROVAL OF THE GRANT APPLICATION OF THE U.S. BUREAU OF RECLAMATION UNDER THE BAY-DELTA RESTORATION PROGRAM: CALFED WATER USE EFFICIENCY GRANTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016 FOR FUNDING UNDER THE ADVANCED METERING INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15301(b) (EXISTING FACILITIES).

WHEREAS, the Advanced Metering Infrastructure Project (Project) technology allows water meters to be read electronically rather than through direct visual inspection by field staff and the meters transmit customer consumption and time-of-use data to the Public Utilities

Department via a radio or cellular network, and will replace existing meter facilities; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (California Public Resources Code sections 21000-21177), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, section 15000, *et seq.*) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that this activity is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301(b), as the repair and maintenance of existing facilities; and

exception to the exemption does not apply.
