A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE HOUSING COMMISSION FOR REHABILITATION OF FOURTEEN PUBLIC HOUSING UNITS LOCATED IN NORTH PARK REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA AND THE NORTH BAY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA.

WHEREAS, the North Park Redevelopment Project Area and the North Bay
Redevelopment Project Area (Project Areas) are redevelopment project areas adopted by the
former Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego (Former RDA) pursuant to the
California Community Redevelopment Law (California Health and Safety Code sections 33000 33855); and

WHEREAS, the Former RDA was engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement the redevelopment plan for the North Park Project Area which was approved and adopted on March 4, 1997 by the City Council of the City of San Diego by Ordinance No.

O-18386, as may be amended from time-to-time, which is incorporated herein by this reference (North Park Redevelopment Plan); and

WHEREAS, the Former RDA was also engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement the redevelopment plan for the North Bay Project Area which was approved and adopted on May 18, 1998 by the City Council of the City of San Diego by Ordinance No.

O-18516, as may be amended from time-to-time, which is incorporated herein by this reference (North Bay Redevelopment Plan); and

WHEREAS, as of February 1, 2012, the Former RDA dissolved by operation of law, and the City of San Diego, solely in its capacity as the designated successor agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego, a former public body, corporate and politic (Successor Agency) became vested with all authority, rights, powers, duties, and obligations of the Former RDA under the California Community Redevelopment Law. As of January 28, 2013, the Successor Agency transferred all housing assets, including Low and Moderate Income Housing Fund monies encumbered by an enforceable obligation, to the City pursuant to California Health and Safety Code section 34176; and

WHEREAS, the City acts as the housing successor to the Former RDA pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 34176; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Housing Commission (Commission) is the owner of that certain real property located at 4890 Naples Street, 2701-2711 Figueroa Boulevard, and 4080 Arizona Street (Properties); and

WHEREAS, the City intends to enter into an agreement with the Commission (Agreement) to rehabilitate a combined total of fourteen public housing units located on the Properties (four apartments at 4890 Naples Street, six apartments at 2701-2711 Figueroa Boulevard, and four apartments at 4080 Arizona Street) to provide permanent rental units affordable to families earning no more than eighty percent (80%) of San Diego County Area Median Income (Agreement);

WHEREAS, under the Agreement, the City will make a one-time lump sum grant payment from available low and moderate income housing bond proceeds to Commission in an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Fifty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$458,000) for the purpose of

rehabilitating fourteen public housing units located on the Properties and imposing affordable

housing restrictions against the Properties for a period of time not less than fifty-five (55) years

in furtherance of the North Park Redevelopment Plan and the North Bay Redevelopment Plan,

and pursuant to Agreements Affecting Real Property to be executed and recorded concurrently

herewith (Project); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The Agreement is hereby approved.

The Mayor, or his designee, on behalf of the City, is authorized to execute the 2.

Agreement, and all other documents necessary and appropriate to carry out and implement the

Project and the Agreement according to its terms, and to administer the City's obligations,

responsibilities, and duties to be performed under the Agreement.

3. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend an amount

not to exceed \$313,000 from the North Bay 2000 Low-Moderate Tax-Exempt Allocation

Bonds, Fund 200562, for improvements to the Housing Commission-owned public housing in

North Bay, and up to \$145,000 from the North Park 2000 Low Moderate Tax-Exempt Tax

Allocation Bonds, Fund 200566, for improvements to the Housing Commissioner-owned

public housing in North Park.
