

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 310576DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUN 29 2016

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO PRELIMINARILY APPROVING THE UPDATES TO THE ASSESSMENT ENGINEER'S REPORTS SUBMITTED IN CONNECTION WITH THE CITY-MANAGED MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017.

WHEREAS, the Maintenance Assessment Districts specified below (collectively, the City-managed Maintenance Assessment Districts) are authorized and administered in accordance with the following laws, as applicable: Article XIID of the California Constitution, the Proposition 218 Omnibus Implementation Act (California Government Code sections 53750-53758), and the Maintenance Assessment District Procedural Ordinance (San Diego Municipal Code sections 65.0201-65.0222); and

cost indexing, maximum assessment rates, and reserve limits; identifying property and land use changes that may impact the calculation of the assessment rate; reviewing the scope of services for improvements to comply with the approved assessment methodology; incorporating general benefit rates proposed for the new fiscal year; and integrating the proposed budget for the new fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, each year the City Council authorizes the appropriation and expenditure of Maintenance Assessment District funds as identified in the updated Engineer's Reports for the upcoming fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, an assessment engineer has prepared such updated Engineer's Reports for fiscal year 2017 to be considered by the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the updated Engineer's Reports submitted in connection with the City-managed Maintenance Assessment Districts, and filed in the Office of the City Clerk as follows, are preliminarily approved as filed:
