A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ADOPTING THE FINAL DECISION TO OVERRULE THE INCONSISTENCY DETERMINATION MADE BY THE SAN DIEGO REGIONAL AIRPORT AUTHORITY FOR A PROPOSED CHICK-FIL-A RESTAURANT LOCATED AT 9370 SCRANTON ROAD – PROJECT NO. 411128.

WHEREAS, Chick-fil-A is proposing to construct a new 2,892-square-foot restaurant on a vacant 1.12-acre property located at 9370 Scranton Road within the Mira Mesa Community Planning area; and

WHEREAS, because of the property's location within the Airport Influence Area of MCAS Miramar, Chick-fil-A must obtain a consistency determination from the San Diego Regional Airport Authority (SDCRAA); and

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2015, the SDCRAA determined that the proposed Chick-fil-A restaurant was inconsistent with the MCAS Miramar Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan (ALUCP); and

WHEREAS, the SDCRAA's inconsistency determination was based primarily on the fact that the property is located within Accident Potential Zone 2, where eating and drinking establishments are prohibited by the ALUCP; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to San Diego Municipal Code 132.1555, an applicant may request a decision from the City Council to overrule a determination of inconsistency made by the SDCRAA; and

WHEREAS, on December 24, 2015, Chick-fil-A requested an overrule by the City Council of SDCRAA's inconsistency determination; and

WHEREAS, on April 26, 2016, the City Council voted to propose to overrule the

SDCRAA and to set a hearing for a final decision to consider an overrule in order to allow for

the proposed Chick-fil-A restaurant within the Accident Potential Zone II of the ALUCP for

MCAS; and

WHEREAS, notice of the proposed final decision and the proposed findings to overrule

the SDCRAA were provided to the SDCRAA, the California Department of Transportation,

Division of Aeronautics, and MCAS Miramar and any comments received have been included in

the final record; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 280(a)(2), this resolution is not subject to veto by the

Mayor because this matter requires the City Council to act as a quasi-judicial body and where a

public hearing was required by law implicating due process rights of individuals affected by the

decision and where the Council was required by law to consider evidence at the hearing and to

make legal findings based on the evidence presented; and

WHEREAS, under the San Diego Municipal Code section 132.1555, a two-thirds vote of

the Council is required for passage of this resolution; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that it adopts the final

decision to overrule the inconsistency determination made by the SDCRAA to allow this

restaurant use in Accident Potential Zone II.
