

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 310608

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUL 20 2016

WHEREAS, each year since 2009, the office of the City Attorney has been awarded a grant from the State Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board (State Agency) to fund a Criminal Restitution Compact Restitution Specialist position in the City Attorney's Office, Criminal Division, for a one-year period; and

WHEREAS, the most recent grant provided funding of \$75,463 per year, for the three-year period from July 1, 2013, through June 30, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the grant agreement between the State Agency and the Office of the City Attorney is intended to establish a positive, collaborative relationship for effective operation of California's criminal restitution system; and

WHEREAS, the agreement helps ensure that restitution fines and orders are properly administered in accordance with applicable statutes; and

WHEREAS, this action would authorize the Office of the City Attorney to apply for and take all necessary actions to secure funding of a grant in the amount not to exceed \$78,586 per year from the State Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board, to fund the Criminal Restitution Compact Restitution Specialist position in the Office of the City Attorney Criminal Division for a three-year period from July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2019, on the terms and conditions outlined in Standard Agreement Number VCGC6077; and

WHEREAS, this action would authorize the Chief Financial Officer to accept, appropriate, and expend up to \$78,586 per year in grant funds from the State Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board, for the purpose of funding the Criminal

Restitution Compact Restitution Specialist position in the Office of the City Attorney, Criminal Division, for a three-year period, from July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2019; contingent upon a fully executed grant agreement or appropriate amendment to extend the funding.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the office of the City Attorney is hereby authorized to apply for and take all necessary actions to secure funding of a grant in an amount not to exceed \$78,586.00 per year for three fiscal years (from July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2019), from the State Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board, to fund the Criminal Restitution Compact Restitution Specialist position in the Office of the City Attorney, Criminal Division, on the terms and conditions outlined in Standard Agreement Number VCGC6077, a copy of which is on file with the City Clerk's Office as Document No. RR- 310608.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the that the City Attorney is authorized to submit all documents, negotiate and execute all agreements necessary, including any amendments, to comply with the grant requirements, and carry out and administer all obligations, responsibilities and duties under the grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend up to \$78,586.00 per year in grant funds from the State Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board, for the purpose of funding the Criminal Restitution Compact Restitution Specialist position in the Office of the City Attorney, Criminal Division, for a three-year period, from July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2019, contingent upon a fully executed grant agreement, and provided that the Chief Financial Officer first furnish one or more certificates certifying that the funds are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing fund for the grant money.
