DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUL 20 2016

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, APPROPRIATE, AND EXPEND GRANT FUNDS OF \$2,386,014 AUTHORIZED BY THE OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM (STEP) GRANT PROGRAM AND ANY AMENDMENTS, EXTENSIONS OR RENEWALS OF THE GRANTS FOR A PERIOD OF UP TO FIVE YEARS, PROVIDED FUNDING IS SECURED AND MADE AVAILABLE, TO FUND PROGRAMS AND DEVELOP STRATEGIES TO REDUCE VEHICLE COLLISIONS RELATED TO ALCOHOL AND OTHER PRIMARY FACTORS.

WHEREAS, the Office of Traffic Safety's Selective Enforcement Program Grant (STEP Grant) was developed to reduce the number of persons killed and injured in crashes involving alcohol and other primary collision factors; and

WHEREAS, in June 2012, the Police Department obtained authorization to apply for, accept and expend STEP Grant funds from FY 2012 to FY 2016 (Resolution R-307632); and

WHEREAS, the Resolution (R-307632) will expire August 2016; and

WHEREAS, under the authority of Resolution (R-307632), in October 2015, the Police Department was award \$1,000,000 to be spent by the end of September 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department has current programs that will expend this money before the end of September 2016 if given authorization; and,

WHEREAS, under the authority of Resolution (R-307632), in March 2016, the Police Department applied for an additional \$1,386,014 in STEP grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the STEP Grant is funded on a regular basis and the Police Department has reoccurring programs that can use the funds if given authorization to apply for, accept, and expend the funds; and

WHEREAS, the STEP Grant will be used to fund programs such as DUI checkpoints, DUI saturation patrols, warrant service operations, stakeout operations, a “HOT Sheet” program, educational presentations, and court stings; and

WHEREAS, the programs may also concentrate on speed, distracted driving, seat belt enforcement, operations at intersections with disproportionate numbers on traffic collisions, and special enforcement operations encouraging motorcycle safety; and

WHEREAS, there will also be community and media outreach that will culminate with in-school and open community safety events; and

WHEREAS, these strategies are designed to earn media attention thus enhancing the overall deterrent effect; and

WHEREAS, the City will use recognized “best practice” strategies, performed on an overtime basis, to accomplish the grant goals; and NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor or his representative is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to expend \$1,000,000 in grant funds from the STEP Grant that was originally applied for and accepted under the authority of Resolution (R-307632).


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that by City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor or his representative, is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend an additional \$1,386,014 in STEP Grant funds if the grant funding is secured.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor or his representative is authorized, for and behalf of the City, to apply for and to take all necessary actions to secure funding from STEP Grants, including any amendments, extensions, or renewals of the grants for a period of up to five years, provided funding is secured and made available.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interesting-bearing fund for the grants, if required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police or designee is authorized to administer and operate the STEP Grants.
