DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUL 22 2016

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO CONFIRMING THE UPDATED ENGINEER'S REPORTS AND THE DIAGRAM FOUND THEREIN FOR THE SELF-MANAGED MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICTS AND AUTHORIZING THE CONTINUED LEVY FOR THE LIFE OF THE DISTRICT, THE COLLECTION OF ASSESSMENTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017 WITHIN THE SELF-MANAGED MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICTS, AND THE RELATED APPROPRIATION AND EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the Maintenance Assessment Districts specified below (individually, a District and collectively, the self-managed MADs) are existing districts as defined in San Diego Municipal Code section 65.0202 and are authorized and administered in accordance with the following laws, as applicable: Article XIID of the California Constitution, the Proposition 218 Omnibus Implementation Act (California Government Code sections 53750-53758), and the Maintenance Assessment District Procedural Ordinance (San Diego Municipal Code sections 65.0201-65.0222); and

WHEREAS, assessment and expenditures of District funds must be in accordance with the written report prepared specifically for each District by an assessment engineer (Engineer's Reports), revised annually to update the District budget and assessments for the prospective fiscal year, and presented to the Council for approval and authorization to appropriate and expend funds as described by the Engineer's Reports; and

WHEREAS, the Council may also approve certain updates to the Engineer's Reports, such as: modifying the assessment rates within the approved assessment formula for cost indexing, maximum assessment rates, and reserve limits; identifying property and land use changes that may impact the calculation of the assessment rate; reviewing the scope of services

for improvements to comply with the approved assessment methodology; incorporating general benefit rates proposed for the new fiscal year; and integrating the proposed budget for the new fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, an assessment engineer prepared updated Engineer's Reports for the period of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017 (Fiscal Year 2017) for each of the City's existing Maintenance Assessment Districts specified below, which updated Engineer's Reports are on file and available for review at the Office of the City Clerk with reference to the following document numbers:


WHEREAS, the Council has held a public hearing and considered all protests, and no majority protest exists with respect to any of the self-managed MADs; and

WHEREAS, there are no proposed increases to the assessments, other than those authorized at the time of formation, including increases based on the San Diego Consumer Price Index; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The Council authorizes the continued levy of assessments in each District for the life of the District.
2. The Council authorizes the collection of assessments on parcels within the District for Fiscal Year 2017 to pay a prescribed portion of the costs of improvements and/or activities as described in each updated Engineer's Report.
3. The updated Fiscal Year 2017 Engineer's Report for each District, and the diagrams located therein, are approved as filed.
4. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate, transfer, and expend District funds, including the management fund, district operating funds, district capital funds, and developer deposit funds associated with new District formation activities for Fiscal Year 2017, contingent upon approval of the Fiscal Year 2017 Appropriation Ordinance, and contingent upon the City Comptroller certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are or will be available.
