A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING A CONSULTANT CONTRACT AND RELATED EXPENDITURES FOR CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION SERVICES FOR THE PARK BOULEVARD AT-GRADE CROSSING PROJECT.

WHEREAS, from its formation in 1958 until its elimination on February 1, 2012, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego (Former RDA) administered the implementation of various redevelopment projects, programs, and activities within designated redevelopment project areas throughout the City of San Diego (City); and

WHEREAS, the Former RDA dissolved as of February 1, 2012, in accordance with a deadline for elimination of all redevelopment agencies throughout California set forth in Assembly Bill x1 26 (AB 26), as modified by the California Supreme Court in *California Redevelopment Assn. v. Matosantos*, 53 Cal. 4th 231 (2011); and

WHEREAS, at the time of the Former RDA's dissolution, the City, in its capacity as the Successor Agency to the Former RDA (Successor Agency), became vested with all of the Former RDA's authority, rights, powers, duties, and obligations under the California Community Redevelopment Law and, by operation of law, received all assets, properties, contracts, leases, books and records, buildings, and equipment of the Former RDA; and

WHEREAS, the Successor Agency is winding down the Former RDA's affairs in accordance with AB 26, enacted on June 28, 2011, and subsequent legislation; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Successor Agency entered into that certain Agreement Regarding Expenditure of Excess Redevelopment Bond Proceeds dated November 14, 2014, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-309247, as amended by the First

Amendment to Agreement Regarding Expenditure of Excess Redevelopment Bond Proceeds dated December 7, 2015, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-309905, and the Second Amendment to Agreement Regarding Expenditure of Excess Redevelopment Bond Proceeds dated February 10, 2016 (collectively, the Bond Expenditure Agreement), which provides for the Successor Agency's transfer of excess non-housing bond proceeds to the City and the City's expenditure of such bond proceeds in accordance with the Bond Spending Plan included as Exhibit 2 to the Bond Expenditure Agreement (Bond Spending Plan); and

WHEREAS, the Park Boulevard At-Grate Crossing Project (Project) will extend Park Boulevard across six railroad tracks to connect with Harbor Drive; and

WHEREAS, the Bond Spending Plan identifies the Project as one of the activities to be implemented by the City using Bond Expenditure Agreement funds now in the City's possession; and

WHEREAS, Civic San Diego administers the Project on behalf of the City pursuant to that certain Agreement for Consulting Services by and between the City of San Diego and Civic San Diego for Successor Agency and Housing Successor Agency Services dated September 26, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Civic San Diego wishes to enter the Professional Services Agreement, attached to Staff Report No. CSD-16-15 as Attachment B (Agreement), with Jacobs Engineering for construction administration services for the Project; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code section 22.3207(b) authorizes the award of a consultant contract for a public works project without City Council approval if (1) the public works project was previously identified and appropriated in, and will be funded through, the Annual Capital Improvement Program budget, (2) the contract does not exceed \$1,000,000, and

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(3) the total cumulative amount of contract awards to the consultant does not exceed \$1,000,000

in any fiscal year. However, Civic San Diego Board Policy 4.0 – Purchasing & Contracting,

requires City Council authorization for professional services contracts of \$250,000 or more to be

executed by Civic San Diego for the benefit of the City; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. Civic San Diego is authorized to enter into the Agreement.

2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed

\$368,873 from CIP S-15045, Park Boulevard At-Grade Crossing, including \$52,894.81 from

Fund 400332 and \$315,978.19 from Fund 400369, solely and exclusively for the Agreement,

contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing a certificate certifying that all funds

necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
