A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO CONFIRMING APPOINTMENTS TO THE INDEPENDENT RATES OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Independent Rates Oversight Committee (IROC) is established in San Diego Municipal Code (Municipal Code) sections 26.2001 to 26.2003 to advise the Mayor and City Council on policy issues relating to the oversight of the City of San Diego's public utilities department operations; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code provides that the IROC shall consist of eleven members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code provides that the members shall serve staggered fouryear terms, each member shall serve until a successor is duly appointed and confirmed, and all terms must expire on May 1; and

WHEREAS, the IROC shall include at least one member from each of the following four ratepayer classes: single-family residential, multifamily residential, commercial and industrial, and temporary irrigation and construction; and

WHEREAS, a majority of the members shall possess expertise in one or more of the following areas: accounting, auditing, engineering, biology or environmental science, finance or municipal finance, law, and construction management; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code provides that a majority of IROC members shall be residents of the City of San Diego, and thus the IROC may include members who live outside of the City, and this requirement will be met by the appointments in this resolution; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the following appointments by the Mayor of the City of San Diego, to serve as members of the Independent Rates Oversight Committee, for the terms ending as indicated, are made and hereby confirmed:
