A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DENYING THE APPEAL AND UPHOLDING THE ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION FOR 3452 HANCOCK MEDICAL MARIJUANA CONSUMER COOPERATIVE – PROJECT NO. 470362.

WHEREAS, an application was submitted for an amendment to a Conditional Use Permit for a medical marijuana consumer cooperative (MMCC) located at 3452 Hancock Street (Project); and

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2016, the Environmental Analysis Section of the Development Services Department determined the project to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15303 (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures) and a Notice of Right to Appeal Environmental Determination was posted; and

WHEREAS, on May 26, 2016, Trisha Phillips filed an Environmental Determination

Appeal Application (Appeal) with the City's Development Services Department stating that the

CEQA Guidelines section 15303 exemption does not apply to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Appeal was heard before the City Council on July 26, 2016; and WHEREAS, the Project involves the addition of 831 square feet to an existing MMCC, resulting in a total of 1,503 square foot within an existing building; and

WHEREAS, the Project is located in the IS-1-1 Zone, the Airport Influence Area, (San Diego International Airport), Coastal Height Limitation Overlay Zone within the Midway/
Pacific Highway Corridor Community Plan area and Council District 2; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 280(a)(2), this resolution is not subject to veto by the

Mayor because this matter requires the City Council to act as a quasi-judicial body and where a

public hearing was required by law implicating due process rights of individuals affected by the

decision and where the Council was required by law to consider evidence at the hearing and to

make legal findings based on the evidence presented; and

WHEREAS, based upon evidence in the record, the Project is exempt pursuant to CEQA

Guidelines Section 15303 (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures) and would not

result in a significant effect on the environment; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Appeal is

hereby denied and based upon the evidence in the record, the environmental determination is

upheld.
