

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 310658DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE AUG 02 2016

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO PREPARE A BALLOT TITLE AND SUMMARY AND AN IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS; DIRECTING THE MAYOR, INDEPENDENT BUDGET ANALYST AND CITY AUDITOR TO PREPARE A FISCAL IMPACT ANALYSIS; AND ASSIGNING BALLOT ARGUMENTS; ALL REGARDING A MEASURE SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, FOR THEIR APPROVAL OR REJECTION AT THE MUNICIPAL SPECIAL ELECTION, CONSOLIDATED WITH THE CALIFORNIA STATE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 2016, AMENDING THE CITY CHARTER BY AMENDING ARTICLE V, SECTION 55, RELATING TO PARK AND RECREATION AND REGARDING BALBOA PARK AND SAN DIEGO HIGH SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code section 27.0504 allows the City Council to direct the City Attorney to prepare a ballot title and summary of any proposed ballot measure; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code section 27.0505 allows the City Council to direct the City Attorney to prepare an impartial analysis of any proposed ballot measure; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code section 27.0506 directs the Independent Budget Analyst, working with the Mayor (or his or her designee) and the City Auditor, to prepare a fiscal impact analysis of a proposed legislative act; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code section 27.0513 allows the City Council to assign to itself, individual Councilmembers, and the Mayor, the authorship and signing of a ballot argument in support of, or in opposition to, a ballot measure; and

WHEREAS, at a meeting held on August 2, 2016 the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 20721, to place on the November 8, 2016 Municipal Special Election ballot, one measure, submitting to the qualified voters of the City of San Diego, for their approval or rejection, one measure amending the City Charter by amending Article V, Section 55, relating to park and recreation; and

WHEREAS, the measure was the result of a proposal by the City Council to place the proposed Charter amendment before the voters; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to Charter section 295(d), this resolution relating to matters to submit to City voters at a Municipal Special Election is not subject to veto by the Mayor, and thus the date of its passage by the Council shall be deemed the date of final passage; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The City Attorney is directed to prepare a ballot title and summary, and an impartial analysis, of the proposed ballot measure for inclusion in the voter pamphlet and to deliver the ballot title and summary, and the impartial analysis, to the Office of the City Clerk, Elections Section, no later than August 22, 2016.
2. The Independent Budget Analyst, working with the Mayor (or the Mayor's designee) and the City Auditor, is directed to prepare a fiscal impact analysis of the proposed ballot measure for inclusion in the voter pamphlet and to deliver the analysis to the Office of the City Clerk, Elections Section, no later than August 22, 2016.

3. Councilmember David Alvarez is authorized to sign and file a written ballot argument in support of the ballot measure for inclusion in the voter pamphlet, and to deliver the argument to the Office of the City Clerk, Elections Section, no later than August 25, 2016.
