A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DENYING THE APPEAL AND ADOPTING THE NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR CHOLLAS WATER OPERATIONS FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS – PROJECT NO. 397650.

WHEREAS, on September 29, 2015, the Environmental Analysis Section of the Development Services Department prepared a final Negative Declaration Initial Study for this project; and

WHEREAS, on July 13, 2016, the Eastern Area Communities Planning Committee (EACPC) submitted an Environmental Determination Appeal Application (Appeal) with the City's Development Services Department stating that the CEQA Guidelines section 15303 exemption does not apply to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Appeal was heard before the City Council on October 4, 2016; and WHEREAS, the Project complies with the minimum required 15-foot setback requirement, maximum 30-foot height limit, and the maximum allowable floor area ratio of 0.45 (total of all buildings combined) for the RS-1-7 zone; and

WHEREAS, the Project provides improvements to a portion of the existing City of San Diego Chollas Water Operations Facility at 2797 Caminito Chollas located in the RS-1-7 Zone, within the Eastern Area of the Mid-City Communities Plan and Council District 4; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 280(a)(2), this resolution is not subject to veto by the Mayor because this matter requires the City Council to act as a quasi-judicial body and where a public hearing was required by law implicating due process rights of individuals affected by the

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decision and where the Council was required by law to consider evidence at the hearing and to

make legal findings based on the evidence presented; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Appeal is

hereby denied.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the City Council that the Negative Declaration has

been completed in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970 (CEQA)

(Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq.), as amended, and the State CEQA Guidelines

thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.), that the

Declaration reflects the independent judgment of the City of San Diego as Lead Agency and that

the information contained in said Declaration, together with any comments received during the

public review process, has been reviewed and considered by the City Council in connection with

the approval of the Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Declaration and other documents constituting

the record of proceedings upon which the approval is based are available to the public at the

office of the City Clerk, 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of

Determination with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Diego regarding

the Project.
