A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA "E" EXPANSION IN THE CLAIREMONT MESA AREA IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINE SECTION 15301 FOR EXISTING FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the existing Residential Permit Parking Area "E" is to be expanded to include the properties on Ashford Street, Ashford Place, Ashford Court, Baltic Street, Cullen Street, Argyle Street, Markham Street and Atlas Street as listed in the Attachment 2; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the expansion of Residential Permit Parking Area "E" in the Clairemont Mesa area; and

WHEREAS, of CT 1820 for City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the project as well as public comment; and

determined that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment as the project is

a minor alteration to existing street facilities with negligible or no expansion of use; NOW,

THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the expansion of Residential Permit Parking Area "E" in

Clairemont Mesa Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines

section 15301.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has

determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2

does not apply.
