FOR DESIGN ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR MORENA PUMP STATION AND CONVEYANCE SYSTEM IS STATUTORILY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15262 (PLANNING AND FEASIBILITY STUDIES).

WHEREAS, this is for approval of an Agreement with AECOM for a duration of five (5) years to perform design and construction support services for the Morena Pump Station and Conveyance System (Project); and

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WHEREAS, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the

written record for the Project as well as any public comment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the

Project will not have a significant effect on the environment because it is planning and feasibility

studies pursuant to CEQA Guideline section 15262; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Project is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA

Guidelines section 15262.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of

Exemption regarding the Project with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of

San Diego.
