A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF APPROXIMATELY 80 ACRES FOR OPEN SPACE PURPOSES WITHIN THE RANCHO PEÑAQUITOS COMMUNITY PLAN AND BLACK MOUNTAIN RANCH SUBAREA PLAN AREAS.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) adopted the Multiple Species Conservation Program (MSCP) Subarea Plan in 1997; and

WHEREAS, the MSCP is a comprehensive habitat conservation planning program that addresses multiple species habitat needs and the preservation of natural communities for an approximately 900 square mile area in southwestern San Diego County; and

WHEREAS, an objective of the MSCP is to conserve a connected system of biologically viable habitat lands in a manner that maximizes the protection of species and precludes the need for future listing of species as threatened or endangered; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to acquire the fee interest in an approximately 80-acre parcel (APN No. 313-010-5900) located west of Interstate 15 and east of Bernardo Center Drive at the terminus of Calle Juanito in the Rancho Peñasquitos Community Plan and Black Mountain Ranch Subarea Plan areas, as shown on Document No. RR-3107777 (the Tom Parcel); and

WHEREAS, the Tom Parcel contains sensitive biological resources and is within a core biological area of the City's Multi-Habitat Planning Area, and its acquisition would protect it from future development and would ensure that onsite habitat and wildlife connections are preserved; and

WHEREAS, acquisition of the Tom Parcel would also allow for a needed link between

two currently unconnected portions of Black Mountain Open Space Park; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his

designee, is authorized and directed to enter into a purchase and sale agreement to acquire the fee

interest of the Tom Parcel, with a purchase price not to exceed \$1,800,000 or the market value of

the property, whichever is lower.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend

an amount not to exceed \$1,840,000 from Fund No. 200697 (Prop C Implementation Obligation

Fund), for the acquisition of the Tom Parcel, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer

furnishing a certificate certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit

with the City Treasurer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute

and deliver all such agreements and all other instruments to effect and complete the transaction

contemplated by this Resolution.
