A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE ACQUISITION OF APPROXIMATELY 80 ACRES FOR OPEN SPACE PURPOSES WITHIN THE RANCHO PEÑAQUITOS COMMUNITY PLAN AND BLACK MOUNTAIN RANCH SUBAREA PLAN AREAS IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO SECTION 15313 OF THE CEQA GUIDELINES.

WHEREAS, declaring that this activity (acquisition of the Tom parcel) is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15313 (acquisition of land for wildlife conservation purposes) which allows for acquisition of lands for fish and wildlife conservation purposes including (a) preservation of fish and wildlife habitat, (b) establishing ecological reserves under Fish and Game Code Section 1580, and (c) preserving access to public lands and waters where the purpose of the acquisition is to preserve the land in its natural condition; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) desires to authorize the acquisition of approximately 80 acres for open space purposes within the Rancho Peñasquitos Community Plan and Black Mountain Ranch Subarea Plan areas (Project); and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has established that the Project categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15313, and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project, and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA, pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15313 (Acquisition of Land for Wildlife Conservation Purposes), which consists of the acquisition of lands for fish and wildlife conservation purposes including preservation of fish and wildlife habitat, establishing ecological reserves under Fish and Game Code section 1580, and preserving access to public lands and waters where the purpose of the acquisition is to preserve the land in its natural condition; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgement, has considered the written record and public comment for the requested authorization, and determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15313, and that an exception to the exemptions as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of Exemption regarding the Project with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Diego.
