A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT INSTALLING ANGLE PARKING ON THE EAST SIDE OF ILLINOIS STREET BETWEEN LINCOLN AVENUE AND POLK IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO EXEMPTION 15301.

WHEREAS, the installation of angle parking on the east side of Illinois Street between Lincoln Avenue and Polk Avenue has been requested; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of installing angle parking on the east side of Illinois Street between Lincoln Avenue and Polk Avenue; and

WHEREAS, on \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment because it involves a minor alteration to an existing public street with negligible or no expansion of use; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that installing angle parking on the east side of Illinois Street between Lincoln Avenue and Polk Avenue is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
