RESOLUTION NUMBER R-310873 DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE DEC 1 3 2016

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ADOPTING A CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR THE FLEET SERVICES DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, Government Code sections 87300 and 87302 require local agencies to adopt conflict of interest codes designating positions that involve the making or participation in making of decisions which may foreseeably have a material effect on financial interests, and for each position, the financial interests which are reportable; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with Government Code section 87306.5, the City is in the midst of a required City-wide biennial review of all conflict of interest codes for which the City Council serves as code-reviewing body; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution R-310531 (adopted by the City Council on June 14, 2016), the City Council directed every City department, agency, board and commission for which the City Council serves as code-reviewing body to make biennial reports and to update their conflict of interest codes as necessary; and

WHEREAS, as the City's code-reviewing body, the City Council finds it in the public interest to adopt the standard conflict of interest code promulgated by the California Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) in Regulation 18730, and hereby declares its intention to incorporate by reference the terms of FPPC Regulation 18730 and any amendments to that regulation duly adopted by the FPPC as part of each conflict of interest code for which the City Council has responsibility; and

WHEREAS, Fleet Services previously was a division of the General Services

Department, but is being reorganized into its own department; and

WHEREAS, this item would create a new Conflict of Interest Code for the Fleet Services

Department, which lists the designated positions in the department and identifies and describes
the disclosure levels against which each person must file a Statement of Economic Interests; and

WHEREAS, the Fleet Services positions previously included in a different conflict of interest code will be removed from the other code, as part of a code update submitted by the Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, the Council is asked to approve the proposed new code; and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 87303 provides that when a proposed conflict of interest code or amendment is approved by the code-reviewing body, it shall be deemed adopted, and, accordingly, this resolution is not subject to veto by the Mayor; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that a Conflict of Interest Code for the Fleet Services Department is hereby adopted, consisting of standard language embodied in title 2, section 18730 of the California Code of Regulations, and any amendments to that regulation duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission, with Appendix A showing designated positions and their duties, and Appendix B showing the disclosure categories.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of Appendix A and Appendix B to the Conflict of Interest Code for the Fleet Services Department as adopted be placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- $\frac{310873}{}$.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in adopting this conflict of interest code for the new

Fleet Services Department, all references to the former division are deemed to be stricken from

the conflict of interest code for the General Services Department that was approved by the

Council on October 23, 2012 as Resolution R-307783.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the persons whose positions are designated in the

Conflict of Interest Code for the Fleet Services Department shall file their statements of

economic interest with the City Clerk in compliance with the schedule set forth in Government

Code section 87302(b) and Fair Political Practices Commission Regulation 18730, or any

amendments thereto, which set forth the deadlines for the filing of initial statements, assuming

office statements, annual statements and leaving office statements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the statements of economic interest filed by

designated persons be retained by the City Clerk and be made available for public inspection and

reproduction.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Conflict of Interest Code for the Fleet Services

Department becomes effective upon the date of adoption of this resolution.
